- Review progress since the 1st Asia Parks Congress in 2013;
- Help set the agenda for protected and conserved areas in Asia for the next 10 years;
- Feed into the design of the next IUCN World Parks Congress;
- Discuss and debate the implications of the new Global Biodiversity Framework for protected and conserved areas in Asia.
